

The GreyGuide seeks to capture proposed as well as published practices dealing with the supply and demand sides of grey literature. This is a collaborative project involving GreyNet International and ISTI-CNR Pisa, Italy.

The test-launch of the GreyGuide Repository took place during a summer workshop at the Library of Congress in Washington D.C. on July 25, 2013. The official launch of the GreyGuide Repository will take place on December 2, 2013 during the Fifteenth International Conference on Grey Literature in Bratislava, Slovak Republic. From now until then, the acquisition of both proposed and published good practices is underway. Your content contribution is greatly appreciated.




