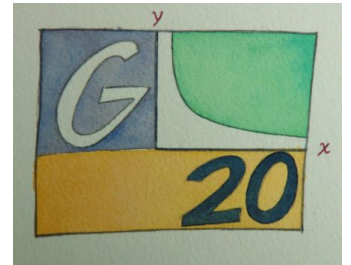

Due Date, Format, and Poster Prize 2018

Abstracts in MSWord should be emailed to conference@textrelease.com on or before **October 30th 2018**. Those submitting poster abstracts will receive verification upon receipt and this will be accompanied by further guidelines for posters, submission of PowerPoint slides, Conference Registration, etc.

Those presenting conference posters are eligible for the Poster Prize 2018 that will be awarded during the GL20 Closing Session. Posters will be judged on their innovative content, relevance to the conference, graphic design, and presentation.
