



**Starting January 2021, every conference paper and journal article published by TextRelease in collaboration with GreyNet International will carry three digital persistent identifiers:**

1. DOI linked to the publication, research output
2. ORCID linked to each individual author(s), researcher(s)
3. ROR ID linked to each of the author's research organization(s)

GreyNet International will mint a DOI for each of the author's publications if they do not yet have one. And, GreyNet will access the ROR IDs of their respective organizations. However, it is the sole responsibility of each author, coauthor and researcher to register their own ORCID ID. If you do not yet have one, simply click

Finally, **please check** to see if your biographical record is in the GreyGuide Repository. If it is not, then please enter it as soon as possible,
